Dear Homeowner,

Greetings from Saginaw-Shiawassee Habitat for Humanity. We are excited to begin planning Critical Home Repairs & Home Preservation projects for 2017.

Each year, Saginaw-Shiawassee Habitat for Humanity applies for grant funds to support critical home repair requests for homeowners. The Critical Home Repair program grants up to \$7,500.00 for eligible repairs. Eligible repairs include: roof, windows, gutters, doors, siding, furnace, water heater, insulation, handicap modifications, etc. Plumbing and electrical are offered to an extent. We also help homeowner in "focus" community neighborhoods with Home Preservation which is exterior painting and minor repairs/landscaping. Our 2017 "focus" neighborhoods are: St. Stephens/Southwest, Thomas Township, Freeland and Shiawassee County.

Please be sure to submit all of the required documents listed on the back of the application when you submit your application for consideration. An application must be completed before it will be reviewed.

Requirements are subject to change per the Federal Home Loan Bank guidelines. The program fee is \$125.00 which includes the title search, credit report and any additional fees. After I have reviewed your application, I will call you for an orientation. You are required to pay any program fees at that appointment.
